I would like to start out with thanking the Red Feather Lakes Fire Supporters, a 501C organization. Without the support of financial aid, many projects for the volunteer fire department would not be possible or delayed. Over the last year the supporters have purchased many items and fixed the fire station itself with funding through the 501C. Here is a list of projects and items that have been purchased in 2022:

1. Stretcher power loader: this device is used to automatically load patients in and out of our ambulances more safely by lowering the risk of injury for our firefighters and patients. \$30,000
2. Twelve air bottles for our newly acquired SCBA packs. \$14,137
3. Repaired the generator that powers the station and the microgrid. \$4,700
4. A UTV rack for side by side. \$1,363

This coming year the supporters can help the fire department greatly with the continued donations for our upcoming projects. The fire department is going to be purchasing a new squad unit that will hold all the technical rescue equipment such as: Ice water rescue, low angle rescue, extrication equipment. We are also looking to update our extrication equipment as well. The supporters can help assist in outfitting this vehicle. The overall cost of these projects is approximately \$50,000, on top of the purchase of the vehicle.

Your donations to the fire department are greatly appreciated. Without these donations we would not have the opportunity to fulfill these upcoming projects. I want to thank you again for your continuous donations and support.
